# School Uniform Checklist

## EYFS and KS1

### Boys -

- ◆ grey shorts or trousers
- ◆ White polo shirts
- ◆ School jumper
- ◆ Black or grey or white socks
- ◆ Black school shoes

### Girls -

- ◆ grey skirt, pinafore or trousers
- ◆ White polo shirt
- ◆ School jumper or cardigan
- ◆ Black, grey or white socks or tights
- ◆ Black school shoes
- ◆ Light blue and white gingham summer

## KS2

### Boys -

- ◆ grey shorts or trousers
- ◆ White shirts (full length button front)
- ◆ School House tie
- ◆ School jumper
- ◆ Black or grey or white socks
- ◆ Black school shoes

### Girls -

- ◆ grey skirt, pinafore or trousers
- ◆ White shirts (full length button front)
- ◆ School House tie
- ◆ School jumper or cardigan
- ◆ Black, grey or white socks or tights
- ◆ Black school shoes
- ◆ Light blue and white gingham summer

### PE KIT - Boys and Girls KS1 & KS2

- ◆ Blue shorts
- ◆ White t-shirts (preferably with the school badge)
- ◆ Plimsolls or Trainers (Velcro until the children can do their own laces please)
